Imperial Fieldflower Water Pitcher

The Fieldflower water pitcher was produced by the Imperial Glass Company, the example above has a smoke base. As water pitchers go it is relatively small in size. It is 8.5" from table to the tip of the spout, and around 4.5" in diameter at the widest point. If you had a complete set of six tumblers you would need to be a bit stingy filling the glasses, I could only fit 5 full glasses in this one. The Fieldflower was reproduced by Imperial and signed with an IG. The water pitchers and glasses come in a wide variety of colors. For the most part you can pick up Fieldflower water pitcher at a sale or auction at a reasonable price. Purple water pitchers with electric iridescence are commanding the highest prices.

I have always liked the Fieldflower water pitcher, they display well on a shelf and when the light hits them just right they are just outstanding to look at. It has taken me some time to find one that has good all-around iridescence that I really liked. I picked this one up a few years ago at auction. It is smoke and the iridescence just lights up when the morning light hits it on my shelf. I think I will keep it a while.
