Greek Key Water Pitcher

The Greek Key water sets were made by Northwood and can be found in marigold, amethyst or purple, and Marigold. Only a few water pitchers or sets are offered at auction each year. Green is just a little harder to find than marigold or purple and will command a higher price. The water pitcher is 11.5 inches tall. I purchased this Green set in 1992 at a Woody sale featuring Bob and Kitty Vining's collection.

Northwood also made plates and bowls featuring the Greek Key pattern. The Greek Key pattern on water pitcher and tumbler differ from the bowls by having an additional pattern above and below the Greek Key.
